LELLE - LET'S LEARN HOW TO LEARN!- RAISING AWARENESS TO THE IMPORTANCE OF AND PROVIDING AN INNOVATIVE SOLUTION FOR THE INCLUSION OF THE TRAINING OF LEARNING SKILLS IN EXISTING HIGHER EDUCATION CURRICULA

Consortium led by the University of Pannonia won the grant titled 'LELLE – Let' learn how to learn! – Raising awareness to the importance of and providing an innovative solution for the inclusion of the training of learning skills in existing higher education curricula' in the frame of Erasmus+ announced by the European Committee in 2015. The European Union supports the project number 2015-1-HU01-KA203-013619 with €302.664 starting on September 1st, 2015 planned ending on October 31st, 2017. The University of Pannonia leads the strategic partnership project collaborating with Europa Consortium Regional Development Non-profit Ltd. (Hungary), BEST Institut für berufsbezogene Weiterbildung und Personaltraining GmbH (Austria), Open University of the Netherlands (the Netherlands) and Wrocław University of Economics (Poland).

The following events were and will be held during the project recently:

Regional Conference in Veszprém – 2017 May

On 25th May 2017 University of Pannonia organized the LELLE (Let's Learn How to Learn) regional conference in Veszprém. During the conference, experts from the Faculty of Business and Economics, University of Pannonia presented the results achieved in the project. Participants were also able to take part in pilot lessons where they could observe how problem solving, critical thinking and the management of students' own learning process skills could be developed. Rita Takács, a psychologist, senior lecturer of ELTE-IK held her plenary speech, after which the high school teachers and students, corporate representatives, university lecturers and students discussed the relevance and applicability of these three skills in the labour market and the potential development of these skills. The collated comments and feedback will work towards the development of the LELLE Handbook.

Regional Conference in Heerlen – 2017 June

The Open University of the Netherlands, Heerlen held the LELLE regional conference on 1st June 2017. The conference theme on “Learning to Learning: Beyond 2020” attracted more than 50 participants from both the educational and non-educational sectors: students, lecturers, working professionals, young entrepreneurs, as well as key industry players. The regional conference had a two-fold objective: first, it aimed to provide the platform for the ongoing discourse on the challenges, as well as the huge potential in the changing educational landscape and the global workplace of the future, and second, it hoped to invite feedback on the findings of the LELLE project research activities on integration of core skill-sets into current higher education (HE) curricula.

Regional Conference in Wroclaw – 2017 June

The Wroclaw University of Economics held the LELLE regional conference on 7th June 2017. Over 60 participants of schools (vocational, high schools), companies related with training and education, universities attended the event. The patronage of the regional conference was prof. Ewa Stanczyk-Hugiet, Dean of Faculty of Management, Information Systems and Finance and the keynote speaker prof. Dariusz Doliński from SWPS University. The conference was held in a dual workshop format: separate workshops for academics and teachers representing other levels of education.

Regional Conference in Vienna – 2017 June

The regional conference of the project “LELLE - Let's learn how to learn!” took place in Vienna on 23rd of June 2017.

Around 30 participants joined the invitation from BEST Institut für berufsbezogene Weiterbildung und Personaltraining GmbH who hosted that event. The majority of the participants (experts/lectors/students) had already received some information about LELLE before the event.

The aim and outputs of the LELLE project were presented at the conference, as well as the development of the three selected core skills - Critical Thinking, Problem Solving and Managing own Learning Process. All participants agreed that those skills should be supported but most of them also thought “positive attitude” and/ or “motivation” to be crucial for finding a perfect job.

In general, the regional conference was a success, participants showed interest in introducing the LELLE KIT in practice.

Meanwhile, the LELLE Kit is in the process of compilation and project team is excited to share it with everybody in Kőszeg on the 26th of September. The meeting took place at Wrocław University of Economics on a rather rainy weather, but it didn't stop us from climbing to the top of Wrocław Sky Tower to see the big picture.

Summer Camp – 2017 August

In August the LELLE Summer Camp was organized by University of Pannonia at the Lake Balaton (Hungary). The aim of the summer camp was to internationalise the LELLE KIT, extending the scope of the created LELLE KIT with identified international/transnational dimensions. The summer camp and international workshops was implemented as the 'closing step' of Output 3 (teaching and coaching period) and the preparation of the pilot version of the LELLE KIT.

International Conference – 2017 September

The next LELLE event will be the International Conference organized by University of Pannonia in Kőszeg (Hungary) on 26th September 2017. Results developed jointly with the partners and the LELLE Kit will be presented during the conference. The LELLE-International Conference provides an excellent opportunity to learn the process and take away hands on experience. The conference aims to bring together stakeholders from international partner institutions, companies, secondary and tertiary educations, trainer enterprises and HR specialist who wish to learn the process of how to develop future workforces' core skills.
