



LELLE Regional Conference 23. June 2017, Vienna

The regional conference of the project "LELLE - Let's learn how to learn!" took place in Vienna on 23rd of June 2017.

29 participants joined the invitation from BEST, who hosted that event. The majority of the participants have already gotten some information about LELLE before the event, especially from experts/lectors/students that are involved in the project or from their colleagues.

They were presented the aim and outputs of LELLE: The development of three selected core skills Critical Thinking, Problem Solving and Managing own Learning Process, as these are crucial for the students to have better employment opportunities. All participants agreed these skills should be improved.

Besides these skills the majority of participants think that "positive attitude" and/or "motivation" are crucial to be developed as well in order to find a perfect job. Additionally it was suggested by one participant to improve the "self-evaluation".

In general those polled are interesting in introducing the "LELLE KIT" in their practice, but for 13 out of 29 one some parts of the "LELLE KIT" are interesting.

The regional conference and the provided information about LELLE received very good feedback. All factors of the questionnaire, from the organisation and implementation to the information on LELLE project – to only mention a few – were rated either with "Excellent" or "Good".

The evaluation of the questionnaires showed that some the participants would like to have "follow-up" or "more practice". They thought it was "innovative" or "new for them", "good to use" and "flexible". Furthermore one participant suggests "involving funding bodies too".











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
